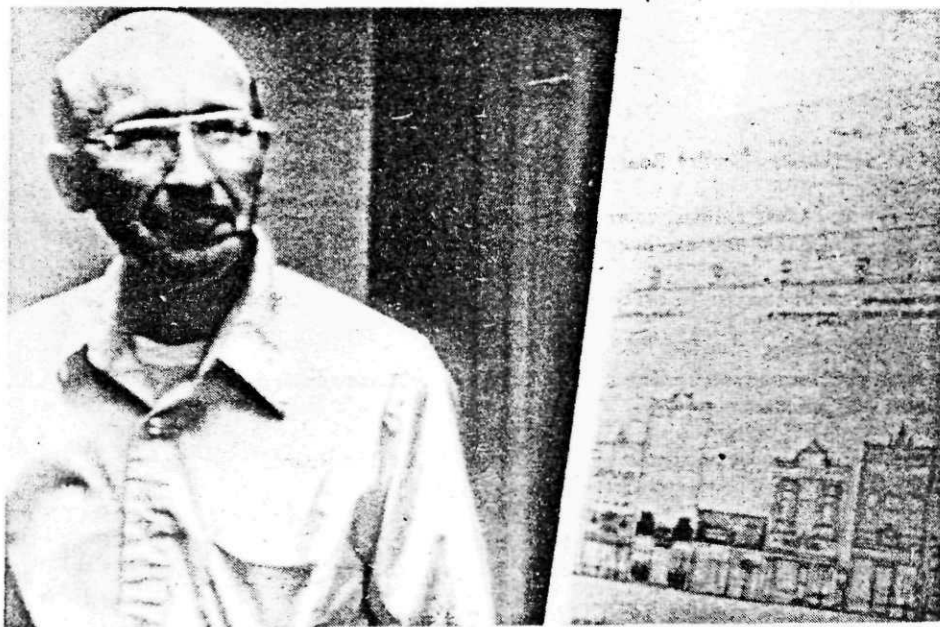

SBA sees architect's plan

Designs for the renovation of the east block of Main Street between Queen and Front Streets were displayed at the recent meeting of the Stockton Betterment Assn. held Thursday evening in the Atwood Room of the Stockton Twp. Library.

The plans, shown by architect, J. Eric Anderson, featured renovation without redesign on the buildings in the block. Included in the block design formulated by the local architect at the request of the Betterment Assn., were street lighting plans and sidewalk designs.

Featured in the sidewalks plans, which were scheduled for discussion at the July village board meeting, Tuesday, were areas designated for the planting of decorative trees. Also featured were globe street lights which may be installed by the village at a later date, the architect said.

Formulation of bylaws for the organization, which will include membership of local business, trades, professional and industrial persons, were presented by Robert Hess, chairperson of the bylaws committee. The

bylaws were ratified by those persons attending the meeting.

The next meeting scheduled by the SBA will be held July 10 in the Atwood Room of the Stockton Twp. Library.
