### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Another year is over. How quickly it goes by. Overall our circulation is down by 1% for the year but our visitor counts are up by 3%. Almost 600,000 visits were made to the Library this year and patrons checked out nearly 1.3 million items. Other notable statistics for the year are meeting room usage up 35% and program attendance up 28%.

Staff is getting excited about the second maker fair to be held on February 1. The print promotional piece about the makerspace is here and the infinity fold flyer has been a big hit with staff. We're excited about handing it out to patrons.

The Marketing Committee introduced its first Library-wide campaign to staff. The "Spread the Word" campaign encourages all staff members to actively use word of mouth advertising to let patrons, neighbors, and friends know about the great things the Library has to offer.
