#### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

The Makery open house was well attended! Approximately 175 people attended several forty five minute tours scheduled throughout the day. Staff members demonstrated the equipment and gave patrons ideas about what's possible for creation. We received many positive comments and patrons seemed very excited to have access to the space.

Daily traffic to the Makery has been steady. Patrons of all ages are venturing down to explore the space. The laser cutter and 3D printers are very popular. The knitting machine has been a big hit with teens and tweens. I've personally enjoyed learning how to use the embroidery machine and have made it my mission to master the knitting machine, which is very finicky.

Summer reading is going well and the Kids' Department has been very busy. The adult summer reading program is going well also. Over one hundred copies of the One Book selection were checked out at last month. The book discussions will begin in July, and it will be interesting to hear how patrons feel about the new program.


