



Amazon Prime

Amazon prime is a membership program that gives customers access to free shipping, video streaming, music, eBooks, and a variety of other benefits. It costs \$99 a year for prime membership.

How can I pay for items on Amazon?

Using your credit card for online or in-person transaction always comes with risk. Amazon uses Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) software, which protects transmissions during checkout. Credit card information is encrypted. If you do not wish to use your credit card, Amazon offers alternative payment methods.

How-to: Set Up a Payment Method

After your Amazon account is created, find the item you wish to purchase. As you checkout, you will be asked: “How would you like to pay?” for your item. In a series of prompts, you can easily enter the major credit card, gift card, or Amazon Pay as your payment option. Then you’re all set. It’s that easy.
