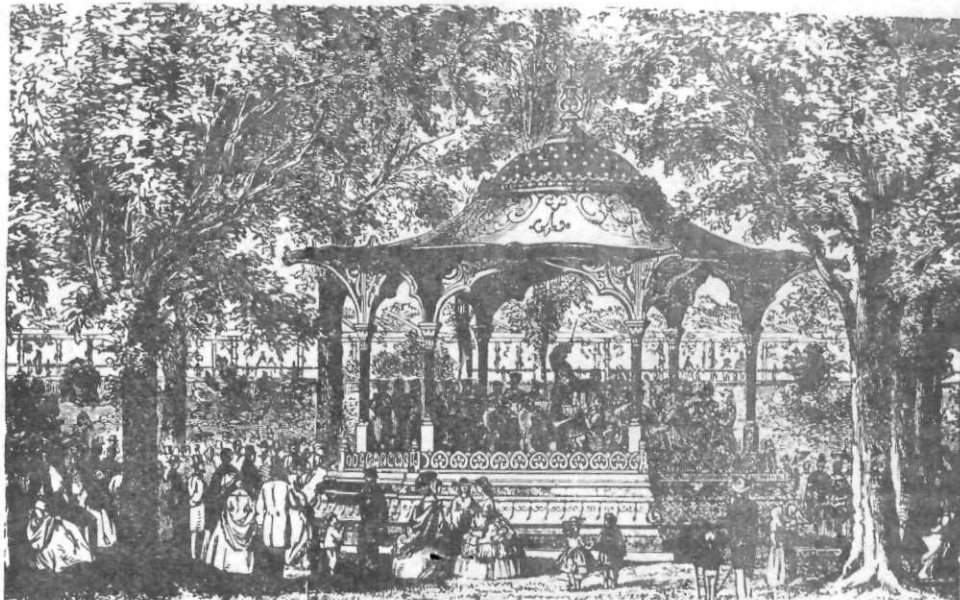
HISTORY LADY
