What are online payment systems and digital wallets?

- An online payment system is an account for you to manage and handle money transfers exchanged electronically
- Digital wallets are electronic devices that make electronic transactions
- Financial info (credit card, bank account, etc.) is stored on accounts and/or apps

Why use them?

- Safety and security!
- These services encrypt your financial info so nobody needs to know your credit card number or bank account info
- Convenience—purchases can be done on your phone so wallets can be left at home
- No more pulling out your credit card in public

PayPal



- Can be accessed on paypal.com or using the PayPal app (iOS and Android)
- Create a free PayPal account and link bank account or credit and debit card info to make purchases of goods and services with no fee
- Can transfer money to your PayPal account to use as your PayPal balance
- Able to send money to friend or family—free when using PayPal balance or bank account, fee of 2.9% plus \$0.30 USB of amount if using debit or credit card
- Personal, Premier, and Business account types
- PayPal Credit provides 6 month flexible payments for purchases over \$99
- Can be used for most retailers online (shown by PayPal logo), and some in-store purchases

Venmo

- Owned by PayPal, so it works similar and has the same fees
- Accessed through venmo.com or using the Venmo app
- Account can be created using Facebook
- Available at some retailers, where Venmo or PayPal button is available

Apple Pay

- Only available through the Wallet app on the iPhone, iPad, and Apple
 Watch with Apple ID signed into iCloud on latest iOS
- Add up to 8 supported cards from participating card issuers—each device setup separately
- Used to pay for items in-store at the register with Near Field Communication (NFC) or Magnetic Secure Transmission (MST) credit card terminals (i.e. chip reader terminals)
- Requires fingerprint touch ID to verify purchase
- Online purchasing available using Safari while signed into Apple ID
- No fee for using Apple Pay, since all transactions occur at a register—no way to send personal transactions to friends or family

Samsung Pay



- Only available through Samsung Pay app on latest
 Samsung phones with Samsung Account
- Purchases can be in-store at registers with Near Field Communication (NFC) or Magnetic Secure Transmission (MST) credit card terminals (i.e. chip reader terminals)
- Some purchases can be made "in-app," similar to PayPal methods
- Can add debit, credit, gift, and membership cards to your Samsung Account (Visa, MasterCard, and American Express accepted)
- Samsung phone must have fingerprint, PIN, or passcode to access phone—also used to verify your identity during purchase
