

PHONE PHOTOGRAPHY

Smartphone Specific:

- ◆ Use two hands
- ◆ Don't forget the rules of photography.
- ◆ Keep your lens clean!

Lighting:

- ◆ Where is the light?
- ◆ Avoid light from the front.
- ◆ Ditch the flash!
- ◆ Adjust exposure and brightness.

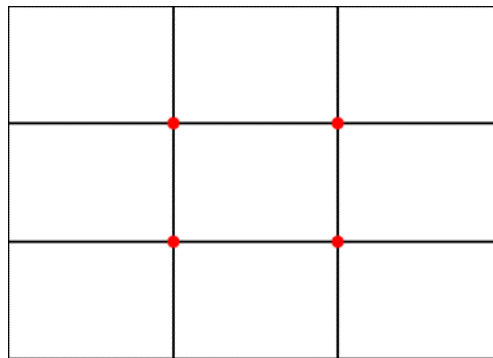
Zoom vs Crop:

- ◆ Zoom happens before you take the photo, altering perspective and can reduce blurriness.
- ◆ *Zoom with your feet.*
- ◆ Crop happens after the photo is taken, and decreases the amount of pixels.

Composition:

- ◆ Center of Interest
- ◆ Subject placement
- ◆ Viewpoint and camera angle

Rule of Thirds



Tips:

- ◆ Volume buttons act as shutter!
- ◆ Press and hold Home button to take "burst photos." Great for action shots!
