## Library Schedules *P. 20010/13/71* Quinn Tyler Exhibit

A retrospective exhibition of the art of Quinn Tyler will be on display at the Elmhurst public library for the month of October.

Quinn Tyler was a resident of Elmhurst, a student of York high school and Elmhurst college. He also studied at the Art Institute of Chicago, where he received his B.A. in 1950 and his M.A. in 1955.

His work has been exhibited in many shows throughout the United States and was awarded prizes in Chicago and elsewhere.

Mr. Tyler was a teacher of art at Alabama State College and at Eastern Michigan University.

He was killed in an automobile

accident in Elmhurst in 1961 at the beginning of a promising career.

This year, the tenth anniversary of his death, the library is presenting a memorial showing of his work in oils, mosaics, sculpture, stitchery, weaving and ceramics.

In the library's permanent art collection are three of Mr. Tyler's paintings, a collage entitled "False Prophet," an oil painting, "Figure with an Angel," and a mixed media painting, "Requiem for a Tone-Deaf Musician."

The 25th class reunion of Quinn Tyler's high school graduating class is being celebrated this October at York high school.
