- Utilize Voice Over for a gesture based screen reader. Settings >> General>> Accessibility>> Voiceover

In settings, you can

- Make text bigger, smaller, or bolded
- Reduce transparency
- Invert, reduce intensity, tint, turn off colors

Hearing

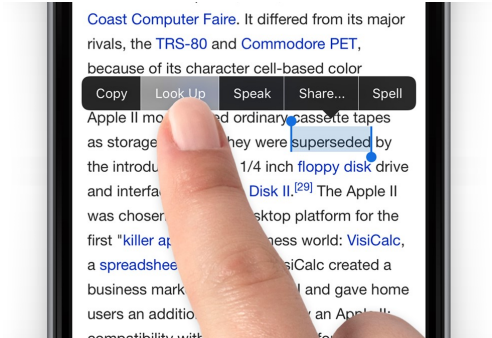


- Apple has worked with many top hearing aid manufacturers to create aids designed specifically for iPhones

Learning and Literacy

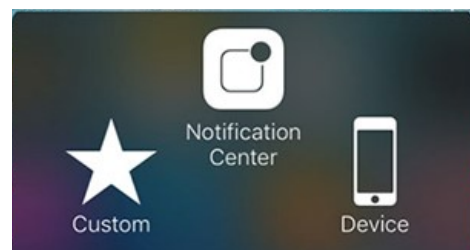


- Safari Reader reduces visual clutter to focus on just the content you want
