ELMHURST, IL — Award-winning author **Joyce Carol Oates** visits Elmhurst March 19, 2009. Her appearance will be the culmination of the Elmhurst Public Library's first annual ELMHURST READS program.

EPL and the Friends of the Library present **Joyce Carol Oates in Person!** at 7:30 PM March 19, 2009. Because of the overwhelming interest in Ms. Oates' visit, the library will hold this event at the 1,000-seat Hammerschmidt Chapel on the campus of Elmhurst College.

This event is free, however tickets are required for entry. They may be picked up at EPL from the Welcome Desk or 2nd Floor Information Desk. A valid EPL card must be shown to pick up tickets. Oates was selected as the author of the first ELMHURST READS series because of the amazing variety and quality of her writing. One of America's most prolific authors, Oates has written novels, plays, poetry, short stories and non-fiction. Her topics have ranged from fictional chronicles of American lives at different points in history to horror, suspense, and even a book on boxing. Several of her works have been made into movies.

Joyce Carol Oates is a recipient of the National Book Award, the PEN/Malamud Award for Excellence in Short Fiction and the Prix Femina. She is the Roger S. Berlind Professor of the Humanities at Princeton University, and she has been a member of the American Academy of Arts and Letters since 1978.
