2015 at a Glance




- 25,529 active Elmhurst Public Library cards (unexpired resident cards)

- 1,296,436 materials checked out.
- 97 public computers were used 296,000 times
- Summer Reading started June 6, 2015. More than 5,000 kids participated. Teens read 390 books and adults read 4,673 titles.
- 47,955 people attended 1,882 Library programs
- The most popular program was the semi-annual Study for Finals event for Elmhurst high school students.
- Local groups gathered at EPL for 853 meetings
- The busiest month of the year was June 2015
- 87,069 reference questions asked
