Next Steps:

Start by creating your free account online, completing the Empower Health Assessment, and registering for your screening at www.empowerhealthservices.info. Within 5-7 business days of the event, return to the portal and you will have secure access to all your screening results. You get 24/7 access to over 1,000 eLearning lessons and tools to help make key health decisions for one full year from the date you register on the portal.

ALLERGY (RAST)* SST #649749

Measures your body's sensitivities to these allergens: dust mites, cat, dog, epithelial, Bermuda grass, Kentucky bluegrass, oak, elm, mold, short ragweed, and English plantain. You should avoid this test if you have had a radioactive scan (e.g., thyroid or bone) in the past week.

ADVANCED THYROID PROFILE SST #224576

Determines thyroid function, including TSH and the Free T4, which is recommended by the American College of Endocrinologists. Thyroid dysfunction can cause unexplained weight loss or gain, fatigue, insomnia and various other symptoms.

A TAKE HOME SELF TEST to detect hidden blood in the stool. Colo-rectal cancer is the third most commonly diagnosed cancer in both men and women.

FEMALE HORMONE PROFILE SST #028480

A blood screening of female hormones (FSH/LH). Correlated with your physical symptoms, it will help determine if you are in or near menopause. Please Note: Estrogen, progesterone or oral contraceptive medications will alter your results. You should not be menstruating or within 3 days of menses.

HEMOGLOBIN A1C* LAV #001453

Determines average blood sugar levels over the period of 90 to 120 days prior to the test. The American Diabetes Association recommends this test be performed four times a year on those who take insulin. Fasting for at least 8 hours is recommended but is not required.

INFLAMMATORY JOINT DISEASE SST #030452

Helps detect and diagnose of Rheumatoid Arthritis, Lupus and Gout. Test includes Uric Acid, CRP, ANA, and RF Factor.

MALE HORMONE (TESTOSTERONE) SST #004226

Measures the hormone testosterone. Results aid in the detection and diagnosis of infertility, impotence and other glandular disorders.

PSA (PROSTATE SPECIFIC ANTIGEN) (please note - PSA test is no longer covered by BCBS PPO, available as self-pay)

Screening for benign or cancerous growth of the prostate in men. As prostate cancer is the most common cancer among men, the American Cancer Society recommends this test as part of an annual prostate screening for men age 50 or over. However, baseline testing is appropriate for men of any age especially those with family history of prostate cancer.

VITAMIN D SST #081950

Measures the level of vitamin D circulating in the blood. Low vitamin D levels have been linked to several cancers, heart disease, stroke, diabetes, depression, weight gain and an increased susceptibility to colds and flu. Although it is rare, taking too much vitamin D can lead to serious health problems including kidney failure.

VITAMIN DEFICIENCY ANEMIA SST #000810

Measures levels of vitamin B12, iron, and folate. Insufficient levels can lead to anemia. Some symptoms of anemia include: fatigue, pale skin and nail beds, shortness of breath, and an elevated heart rate.
