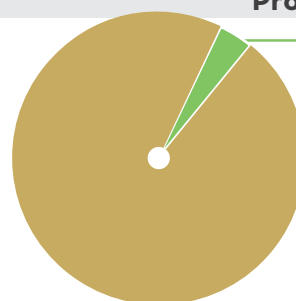

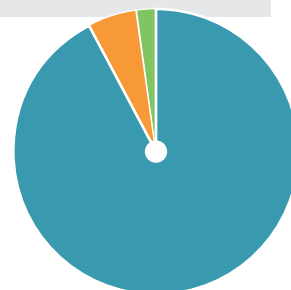


Library taxes are \*3.70% of your tax bill

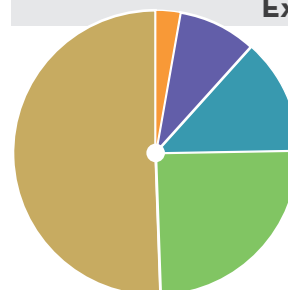
