

2024-2025 Stitch-Along: Astrology

A stitch-along is a mystery cross-stitch pattern where new parts of the design are released each week. Every Sunday, we send you the next piece until you have a completed pattern. This is an asynchronous program where everyone stitches at their own pace.

This year's theme is astrology and each week's design will contain information about the twelve signs. Because the astrological calendar is dictated by the equinoxes (first day of each season), it is important to look at the year you were born when determining your own sun sign, as well as other placements. To create a free chart online, visit <http://alabe.com/freechart> and input your birth date, place of birth, and time of birth. If you do not know your time of birth, enter 12:00 p.m.

A Note on Long Stitches

In this year's pattern, we are using a long stitch, also called a long backstitch, in addition to the traditional cross stitch. The long stitch is the easiest stitch in embroidery and cross-stitching. We will be using this for the text below each design. All of the long stitches will be made using DMC 3820, the same color used for the outlines in week 1.

Each line of the letter will be a separate backstitch, stretching from each end of the line you want to create, rather than individual stitches like you would do in backstitching. Some may be only one stitch long, while others may be five or six.

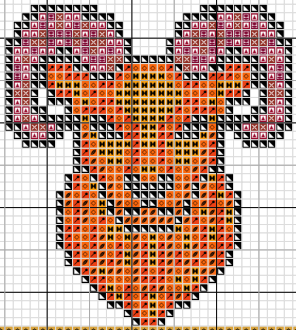
Week 9: Scorpio
