### **Highlights from February:**

On February 12, the Library held its first Facebook Live class. Molly Schlecht, Graphic Designer, and Jeannine Lau, Digital Content Librarian, presented a livestream soapmaking class. Cheryl Moore, Public Information Coordinator, handled videography and technical issues. The goals of this class were two-fold: to provide an accessible class for folks limited by inclement weather or driving in the dark, as well as to investigate how we can incorporate streaming technology into how we present events. We it's peak, we had 19 viewers.

A lot was learned from teaching this class. We'll be investigate different kinds of recording equipment for future attempts. Also, we're considering what kind of programs would benefit from a livestream. We'll be incorporating some shorter Facebook Live videos to market some of the Library's offerings in the near future too!
