Director's Report

It's been two and half months since we reopened. We're exploring options for providing more service since things have been going well. The Makery will reopen with reduced hours on a reservation basis on September 17. We're hoping to reopen the Creative Studios in October and we are planning on reopening the study rooms soon. We're also discussing allowing patrons to stay longer than an hour from 7:00-9:00. This time slot is consistently our least busy time. We're also going to try ending the reservation requirement and moving to a hybrid model. Patrons will need reservations for the Makery, the study rooms and the creative studios. Regular visits will be on a walk-in basis but the 60 person/hour limit will still be in effect. We have two months of data and anecdote as to how patrons are using the Library during the pandemic and easing up on some of the restrictions seems like a good idea. We will continue to assess the situation and we will bring back the reservation system if capacity limits become an issue. As always, we will follow the guidelines issued by the State and will revert back to a more limited model if necessary.

Patron interactions remain steady but are still less than they've been in non-COVID times.



MARKETING DEPARTMENT REPORT

August 2020


In August, the Marketing Team started an accessibility evaluation for all of EPL's digital marketing outlets. Our digital reach has increased tremendously since the pandemic started, so we thought we would take some time to evaluate what is working and what needs tweaking. We each did our own research regarding best practices for each of our niches (messaging, graphics, social media, website, programs) and then came together to discuss an article, *Federal Social Media Accessibility Toolkit Hackpad: Improving the Accessibility of Social Media for Public Service*, a "...shared document for the development of the Social Media Policy Toolkit, a shared service of the Federal Social Media Community of Practice lead by teams including The Department of Labor's Office of Disability Employment Policy." Some of the changes that came out of our discussion and research are: more conscientious use of "plain language" in social media posts, using less text in posters and graphics, and using camel case in hashtags. I am pleased to report that many suggested best practices were already in place.

An extension of that exercise has been reviewing the closed captioning on our YouTube programming. The autogenerated option currently available is glitchy and imprecise. We are collaborating with Kids' Library staff to determine the best process of editing the existing closed captioning. At the end of four weeks we will review our findings and time spent to figure out next steps.

Other August highlights include:

- Partnering with the Elmhurst History Museum. The Library served as a destination in their community-wide game of Clue.
- Celebrating Jake Downey, the creator of EPL's Adventure Backpacks, as he achieved Eagle Scout status.
