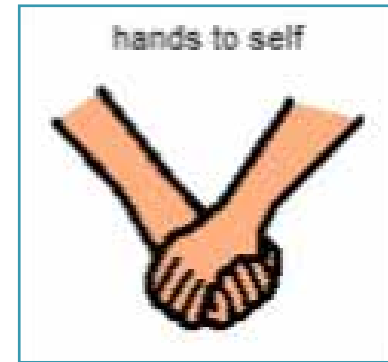

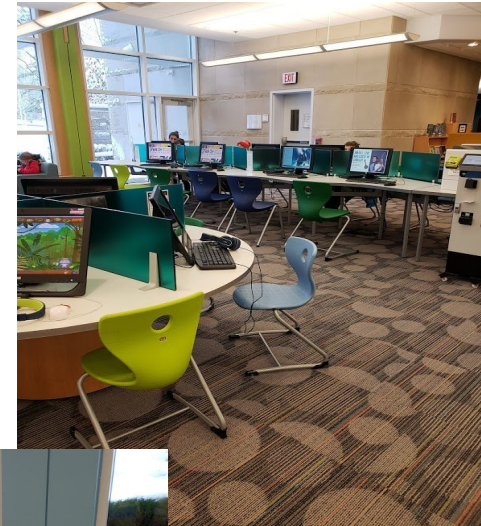
Going to the Library can be fun.

It also has other things to do and see.



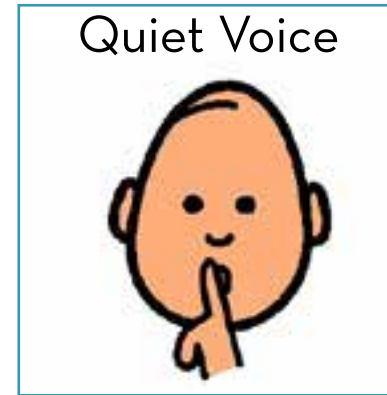
The Kids' Library has an aquarium.

I can find a place to sit and read or play quietly.



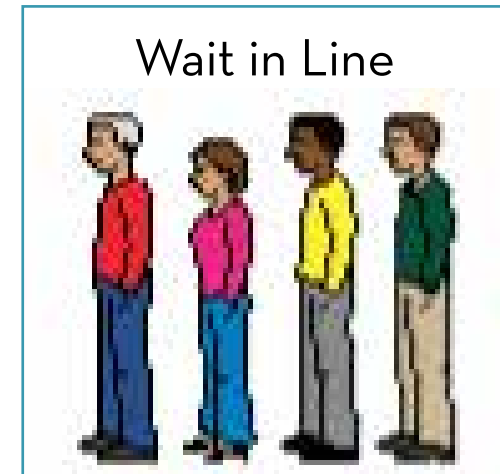
Drink - Bathroom
