

Filtering Information

In compliance with the federally mandated provisions of the Children's Internet Protection Act, the Elmhurst Public Library filters all of the Library Computers, including Internet access from personal laptops using the plug-in or wireless connections throughout the building. In accordance with the Supreme Court ruling on this legislation, anyone age 17 or older who needs to view a blocked site for research purposes should speak to staff at the 2nd floor Information Desk for assistance.
