



## How to download eBooks




# FINDING AND CHECKING OUT TITLES

1. Using a computer, go to [elmlib.org/ebooks](http://elmlib.org/ebooks).
2. Click on  **MyMediaMall**.
3. Click on **Sign In**.
  - Choose Elmhurst Public Library.
  - Enter your library card number and PIN.
4. Find a title.
5. If the title is currently checked out, **Place a Hold** to be notified via email when your item is ready for checkout.
6. If the title is available, click **Borrow**. When selecting Borrow, users are prompted at the top of the screen to go to the **Loans** page to select the format.



7. Under **Choose a Format**, select **Kindle Book**. Amazon's website will open to proceed with the download.
  - **Read Now** is for reading in a computer browser.

**PRO TIP:** Only want to see titles available for the Kindle?  
Go to **My Account**, click on **settings** and select [ ] **Kindle Preference**.  
This will only show the Kindle book option for eBooks.



# DOWNLOADING AN eBook

1. Click **Get for Kindle**.



2. When the Amazon website opens, click **Get Library Book**.
3. **Sign in** to your Amazon account.
4. Select the device to which you would like to send the eBook and click **Continue**.
5. Your eBook will be delivered the next time you turn on your Kindle and enable WiFi\*.

*\*If you do not have access to WiFi or if you are using a first generation Kindle or Kindle DX, download the eBook and transfer it to your Kindle via USB cord.*
