John Mueller came to Elmhurst in 1864 and was married in 1893. Mr. Mueller was one of the early carpenters in the village and built many of the beautiful old homes such as the <sup>M. W.</sup> M. W. Murphy residence on West St. Charles Road, the Law and Brush residences on Claremont Avenue, as well as most of the houses that he built after he subdivided his 8 acres around Pine and Schiller Streets. He also supervised the moving of the tavern from St. Charles Rd. to 413 S. York Street, the present residence of Mr. and Mrs. Durham. Mr. Henry Glos and Mr. Mueller scoured the surrounding country for trees and they are the men who planted the beautiful trees on Schiller St. and First St. east to the village limits. Mr. Mueller was one of the early village trustees and one of the aldermen of the City of Elmhurst for many years.
