Mueller, John

was one of the early earpenters in the village and built many of the beautiful eld homes such as the N. W. Murphy residence on West St. Charles Road, the Law and Brush residences on Claremont Avenue, as well as most of the houses that he built after he subdivided his 8 acres around Pine and Schiller Streets. He also supervised the moving of the tavern from St. Charles Rd. to 413 S. York Street, the present residence of Mr. and Mrs. Durham. Mr. Henry Glos and Mr. Hueller secured the surrounding country for trees and they are the men who planted the beautiful trees on Schiller St. and First St. cast to the village limits. Mr. Hueller was one of the early village trustees and one of the aldermen of the City of Elmhurst for many years.
