Elmhurst Public Library and Local Model Railroad Club Hold Raffle for Train Display

The model features Elmhurst landmarks, like the Elmhurst water tower, police station, fire station, District 205 school building, and a church. It even has working railroad-crossing arms. Not only did the club donate the custom-built display; they also will deliver and set it up in the raffle winner's home.
