Getting Started

1. Using a computer, go to app.overdrive.com.
2. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and select the option that describes your computer.
3. Follow prompts to download app.

Finding and Checking Out eAudiobooks

1. Go to elmlib.org/audiobooks.
2. Click on .
3. In the top right corner click **Sign In**.
 - Choose Elmhurst Public Library
 - Enter your Elmhurst Public Library card number and PIN.
4. Find a title to checkout.
5. If the title is currently checked out, **Place a Hold** to be notified via email when your item is ready for checkout.
6. If the title is available, click **Borrow**.

The book can then be found under your account **Loans**. 

Downloading an eAudiobook

1. Select the format and click **Download**.
2. A download box will appear. Select **Save**.
3. A box will confirm where the file will be downloaded.
4. Audiobooks are downloaded in parts; you can download all or selected parts.
5. Connect your device and select the **Transfer** button to add your audiobook to your device.

Getting Started

1. Go to the elmlib.org/emusic and select **freegal**.
2. Login with your Elmhurst Public Library card number and PIN.

Finding and Downloading eMusic

1. Search by **Artist**, **Song**, **Album**, or **Composer**. Browse by **Trending**, **New Arrivals**, or **Genres**.
2. Select the download arrow  to download a song. The song file will be saved to your computer.
